The Masonic Hall is a listed building and before any work/replacement is carried out Essex County Council (and so via English Heritage) had to give permission for the type of roof covering used to replace the lead covering that was stolen. Originally insisting on the lead being replaced with lead, after some pressure they finally agreed to only a zinc alternative. The above pictures, taken by Terry Delf on 2nd November 2010, show the zinc roof being laid.

In the pictures it still has the protective 'paper/plastic' covering. this will be removed of course. It is anticipated that the roof will be finished and scaffolding taken down within the week. When this has been done, the Temple will be re-painted and finally all the work which has taken many months will be complete.
